I wish you the sunshine of tomorrow.

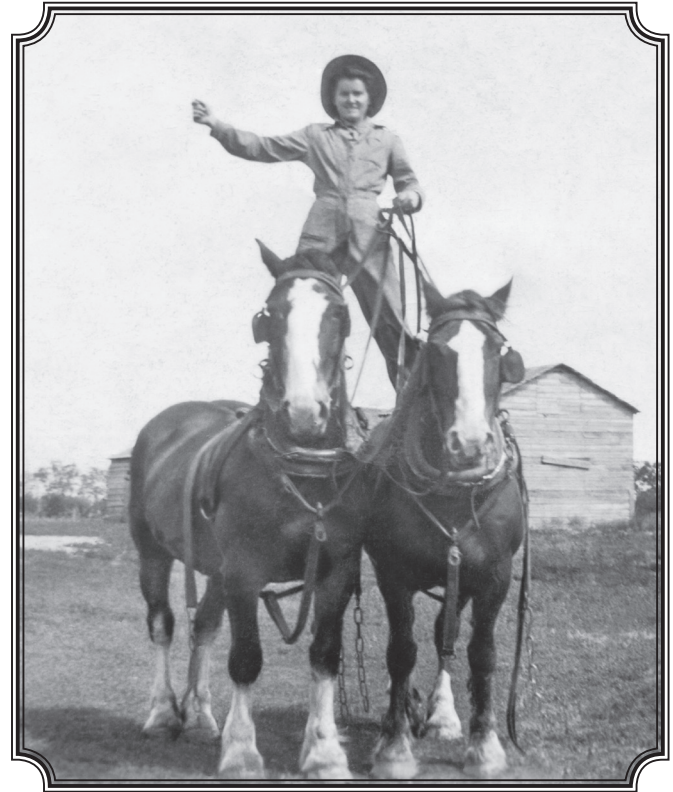
My life's been full, I've savoured much

God wanted me now, He set me free.

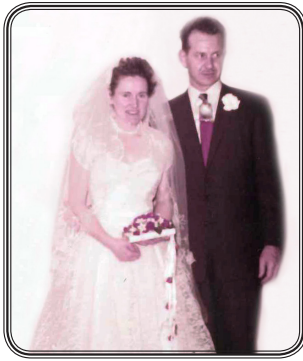
