through the church the song goes on.

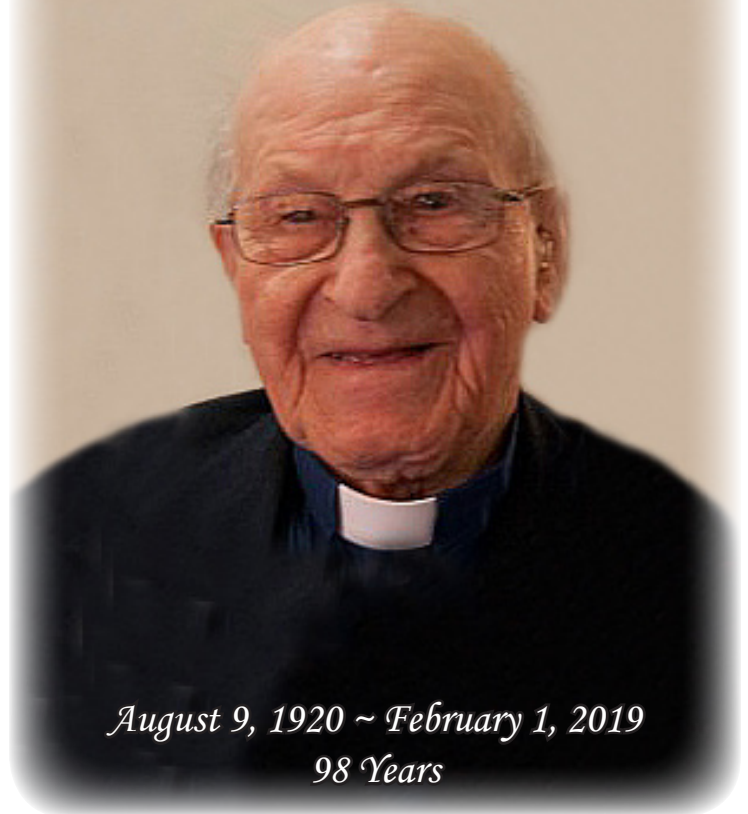
Holy Father, Holy Son,

Reverend Theodore Bruno Roy of St. Joseph's Integrated Care Centre, Lestock, SK, passed away quietly at All Nations' Healing Hospital, Fort Qu'Appelle, on Friday, February 1, 2019, at the age of 98, after a short illness. He was born in Meyronne, SK, where he attended school and helped on the family farm. He enlisted during WWII and served overseas as a Crash Rescue Firefighter. After the war, he joined the Royal Canadian Legion to support the veterans and was a member for 75 years. During those years, he held many executive positions in Saskatchewan. He returned home to farm, then went back to school and studied to become a priest. He was ordained June 12, 1954, in Meyronne. Fr. Roy served in many different parishes in the Archdiocese of Regina and the suppressed Diocese of Gravelbourg, ending up in Quinton in 1982 where he lived and worked until moving to Raymore in 2012. Fr. Roy provided chaplaincy services to St. Joseph's Integrated Care Centre until 2014, when he became a permanent resident at the home. Fr. Roy is survived by his sister, Bonnie and several nieces and nephews.
